

From April 2014 – March 2015 Gift Aid was worth over £67,000 to Wakefield Hospice.

If you are a tax payer, HM Revenue & Customs will contribute an extra 25p for every £1 you donate through Gift Aid, at no cost to you. This will increase your donation by a quarter, so for every £10 you donate we could receive £12.50.

If you are a higher rate tax payer you can claim further tax relief so your donation costs you less.

Gift Aid applies to most donations, regardless of the amount or frequency you donate. To enable Wakefield Hospice to claim Gift Aid on your donations, all you need to do is complete the form opposite and return it to us in the attached envelope.



How do I know if I am a UK taxpayer ?

- tax is taken from your wages or pension before you receive them
- you have to fill in a self-assessment form
- you pay tax on savings (in a building society, for instance), pension plan or investment income
- you have recently paid capital gains tax, or expect to pay it in the near future. (This could be on the sale of a property or some shares, for example.)

If any of these apply to you, please complete the form opposite so we can claim Gift Aid and increase the value of your donation.
